

# SCHOOL BUILDING BOOM

New Orleans public schools are beginning to experience a historic building boom under the first phase of a master plan, covering four to five years. Dozens of campuses will see new construction or extensive renovations, which could make the Recovery School District and the Orleans Parish School Board national leaders in building energy-efficient schools. Post-Katrina FEMA rebuilding grants are providing the bulk of the financing.
